# OLD TESTAMENT SCRIPTURE READING

*Jeremiah 8:18 – 9:9*

- 18 My joy is gone; grief is upon me;  
my heart is sick within me.
- 19 Behold, the cry of the daughter of my people  
From the length and breadth of the land:  
“Is the LORD not in Zion?  
Is her King not in her?”  
“Why have they provoked me to anger  
with their carved images  
and with their foreign idols?”
- 20 “The harvest is past, the summer is ended,  
and we are not saved.”
- 21 For the wound of the daughter of my people  
is my heart wounded;  
I mourn, and dismay has taken hold on me.
- 22 Is there no balm in Gilead?  
Is there no physician there?  
Why then has the health of the daughter  
of my people  
not been restored?
- 1 Oh that my head were waters,  
and my eyes a fountain of tears,  
that I might weep day and night  
for the slain of the daughter of my people!
- 2 Oh that I had in the desert  
a travelers’ lodging place,  
that I might leave my people  
and go away from them!  
For they are all adulterers,  
a company of treacherous men.
- 3 They bend their tongue like a bow;  
falsehood and not truth  
has grown strong in the land;  
for they proceed from evil to evil,  
and they do not know Me, declares the LORD.

4 Let everyone beware of his neighbor,  
and put no trust in any brother,  
for every brother is a deceiver,  
and every neighbor goes about as a slanderer.  
5 Everyone deceives his neighbor,  
and no one speaks the truth;  
they have taught their tongue to speak lies;  
they weary themselves committing iniquity.  
6 Heaping oppression upon oppression,  
and deceit upon deceit,  
they refuse to know Me, declares the LORD.  
7 Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts:  
“Behold, I will refine them and test them,  
for what else can I do, because of My people?  
8 Their tongue is a deadly arrow;  
it speaks deceitfully;  
with his mouth each speaks peace to his neighbor,  
but in his heart he plans an ambush for him.  
9 Shall I not punish them for these things?  
declares the LORD,  
and shall I not avenge Myself  
on a nation such as this?”

## GOD CLEANSSES US

*We gather each week as sinners in constant need of His mercy. The corporate confession of sin acknowledges this and invites honest expression before God. However, God isn't silent as we cry out to Him — He assures us that His grace is bigger than our sin. God's forgiveness is for all those who humble themselves before Him in Christ Jesus.*

## CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

**P: Merciful God, we have sinned against You  
times without number,  
been guilty of pride and unbelief,

#### *Galatians 5:18–26*

<sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. <sup>19</sup> Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, <sup>20</sup> idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, <sup>21</sup> envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. <sup>24</sup> And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

<sup>25</sup> If we live by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. <sup>26</sup> Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.
