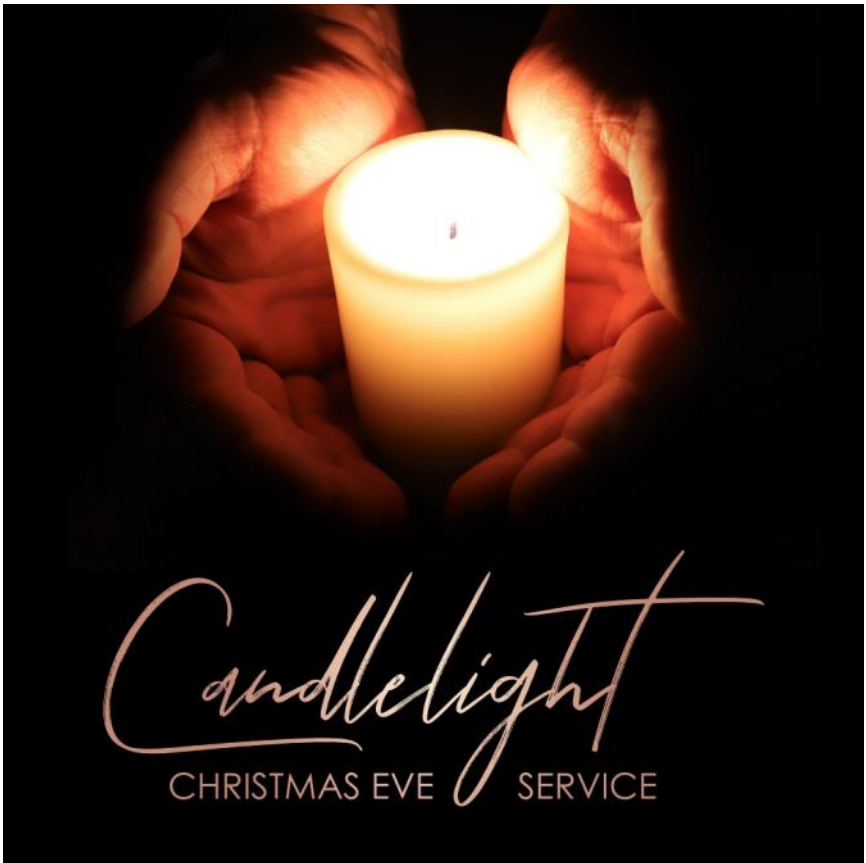

*Isaiah 7:14, Isaiah 11:1–5, Isaiah 22:22, Malachi 4:2*

- <sup>14</sup> Therefore the LORD Himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.
